METHODS OF PAYMENT

A. MONTHLY AUTO PAY - AS EASY AS 1-2-3

Continuous membership through payment of a low monthly fee. 1. Complete a membership application form

- 2. Complete and sign authorization for bank or credit card company to make monthly membership payment to YMCA.
- 3. Provide YMCA with a voided check/credit card number and
- a down payment (first month and joining fee).
- 4. 50% of the Processing Fee will be deferred for as long as you are enrolled in Auto pay.

Cancellation must be in writing before the last day of the month.

B. 1-Month, 3-Month, 6-Month, or ANNUAL PAYMENT

YMCA Memberships are a subscription and that as such it will continue to auto-renew monthly unless written cancellation is provided on or before the last day of the month or by the 20th of the month for payroll deduction.
If written cancellation of membership is not provided by the last day of the month or the 20th for payroll deduction member is responsible for any charges to the account.

• Members will owe the monthly membership rate regardless of whether or not the facility was utilized.



LACROSS CAMP – JEREMY BULLOCK FIELD




